MIRACLES CLASS ADDS ABILITY MINISTRY CURRICULUM

With the opening of the Shine Suite, a new curriculum was introduced for our Miracles Class, which meets each Sunday at 11:15 am. Starting in August, our students started weekly lessons from Ability Ministry, an independent Christian non-profit ministry which strives to enhance the lives of persons affected with disabilities. The primary mission for Ability is equipping and empowering disability ministry for churches, families, and individuals affected by disabilities to become who God has created them to be.

One of the ways they do achieve their mission is through the creation of interactive, Bible-focused curriculum for teens and adults. During the first month of weekly classes in the Shine Suite, our Miracles students worked through Ability's "Be Strong" series. For September, students are learning from the "Be Healthy" series, while in October, the focus will turn to the "Be The Church" series.

The Shine Ministry team is thankful for the partnership with Ability Ministry and for the Gospel-focused team who is committed to ministering to individuals and families affected by disabilities.

FAO: WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE SHINE MINISTRY SUITE

When is the Shine Suite open during weekend services?

The Shine Suite offers worship classes during both the 9 am and 11:15 am services. Check-in for the 9 am service is open from 8:30 am until 9:20 am. Check-in for the 11:15 service is open from 10:45 am until 11:35 am. The Shine Suite is closed from 10:15 am until 10:45 am for cleaning.



Where should we park and enter the building when we arrive?

We strongly suggest entering the building at Door 10, which is under the Shine Ministry signage on the outside windows of the Shine Suite. There is ample parking in Lot D near Entrance 2 on Watterson Trail, which is a short walk to Door 10.

Where is the Shine Suite located inside the church?

The entrance to the Shine Suite is

accessible from the 2nd floor of the Atrium between the Media Center and the living room classrooms. If you enter the building from Door 10, use the elevator just inside the Atrium and the Shine Suite is on the 2nd floor.

How does check-in and check-out work in the Shine Suite?

Check-in kiosks are located inside the Shine Suite. All students (kids, teens and adults) will be checked-in at one of our kiosks and each of them will receive a check-in label to enter our worship spaces. Parents, guardians or caregivers accompanying our students will receive a unique code for check-out after worship. All students should be checked out immediately following the completion of the worship service. Our Shine Welcome Team will be on site to assist our families with the check-in and check-out process.

What will a typical Sunday morning look like inside the Shine Suite?

For Shine Kids, each class session will feature worship and Bible storytelling time, crafts/coloring and free play. For our 2:46 and Miracles classes, students will enjoy age-appropriate worship, Bible lesson, crafts and fellowship time. Our team of Shine volunteers provide a safe, loving and Gospel-centered environment during each of our weekend classes.

What safety precautions are in place in the Shine Suite?

Health screenings are administered for students and volunteers prior to entering the Shine Suite. All volunteers are wearing personal protective equipment (masks, face shields, etc.) while serving. Following the completion of each service, the Shine Suite is cleared and cleaned with all surfaces disinfected. Students have their own worship spaces to provide safe social distancing. Students and families with an increased risk of contracting COVID-19 are encouraged to stay healthy at home and worship online.


